



Without a proper progress reporting tool, it was difficult to track and maintain project progresses as well as productivity tracking of their employees.



RESULTS AND IMPACT






Delay Analysis:

 Major delays were caused due to Material Unavailability, Equipment Unavailability, Improper Weather Conditions, Non-accessibility of site (due to Legal Compliance issues) & lastly due to Manpower shortage




Trend Analysis:

Done Using Plan v/s Actual Qty Tracker

Conclusion:

- Execution Status remained Poor for the entire 2022, with average variance being -45% of the Plan
- The Project Plans were not met which added to the execution delay every month & increased the cost overrun altogether



MITIGATION STRATEGY ADVISED:



Client needs to eliminate the following red flags in order to execute the Project as per revised timelines:

- Increase Manpower Which in turn will reduce the Manpower shortage & ramp up the execution of the activities.
- Advance Procurement The Site team needs to update Store well in advance of the materials required which in turn needs to be procured by the Purchase department.
- Hire Equipment & not invest in it Present Trends depict higher breakdown of Equipment's which have caused delays, hence Equipment's should be hired and not procured in-house so that Downtime can be prevented & depreciation of asset could be mitigated.
- Health & Safety Issues The site safety should be enhanced by improving the practices to stop delays caused by HSE Issues
